

## Faculty/Mentor Travel Support

Faculty and other mentors traveling to the Spring 2011 ACS National Meeting in Anaheim, California with NSF-REU/LS-AMP LG Travel Award recipients are eligible to receive \$250 in travel support. Each mentor can receive only \$250, regardless of how many students they are mentoring at the ACS meeting. **Students will be asked to name the mentor** with whom they might travel in their travel award applications, and when the awards are announced, the named mentor will be contacted in order to finalize the details of the Mentor Travel stipend. Any Mentor Travel funds which are not used by mentors will be applied to funding additional undergraduate students.

In order to receive the travel support, the faculty mentor must attend both the REU/LS-AMP Travel Awards Reception on Sunday March 27, 2011 at 5:00 pm and an Awards Lecture on Tuesday March 31 at noon during the Anaheim, California ACS Meeting. The Awards Reception is scheduled for the first evening of the ACS meeting, and will include representatives from the NSF, as well as members of the NSF REU Leadership Group.

Mentors should work with students in preparing their abstracts and their applications for the travel awards.
