## UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH PROGRAM

### ELIGIBILITY:

- Majoring in a field of science, technology, engineering or mathematics (STEM)
- Possess an interest in research
- Full-time enrollment, with a minimum 2.5 GPA
- Have at least two (2) semesters remaining in undergraduate education
- U.S. Citizen or permanent resident
- Positive letter of recommendation from STEM faculty member

The National Science Foundation's Louis Stokes Alliance for Minority Participation (LSAMP) is a program designed to increase the quantity and quality of underrepresented students in science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM).

### PROGRAM BENEFITS

- Faculty supervised research
- Academic and professional enrichment seminars
- Connect to a system wide network of undergraduate and graduate STEM students
  - Supplemental instruction in math/science courses
  - A stipend of up to \$3000/year depending on classification
- Assistance with preparation for GRE and graduate school applications
